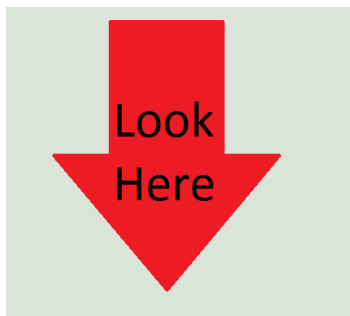

additional members. We always meet on Monday, immediately after the 2:10 Dismissal Bell. **I will meet the Rosary Club students in the GYM at dismissal time** as this will be SAFER for them. (The lobby of school can be a very busy place during dismissal!)

We will meet by the stage area so we can stay out of the way of the classes that are leaving the school. The students will need a permission slip or a written note, so I know that they are supposed to be going to Rosary Club. Please send the bottom slip in Monday morning, so I know who to look for in the afternoon.

Rosary Club will go from 2:10-3:10 starting in the gym and ending in the Chapel. We will not walk over to the chapel until the cars have all dismissed from the 2:10 pick-up time.
