**BEFORE & EXTENDED CARE**  
Daily, Assumption offers 7AM Before-Care, with Extended-Care following immediately after school until 6PM.

**DAILY SCHEDULE**  
The school day begins at 7:45 AM and ends on Monday at 2:10PM, allowing for Faculty meetings. Tuesday through Friday, the school day ends at 3:10PM.
