Optional Extra Activity Ideas:

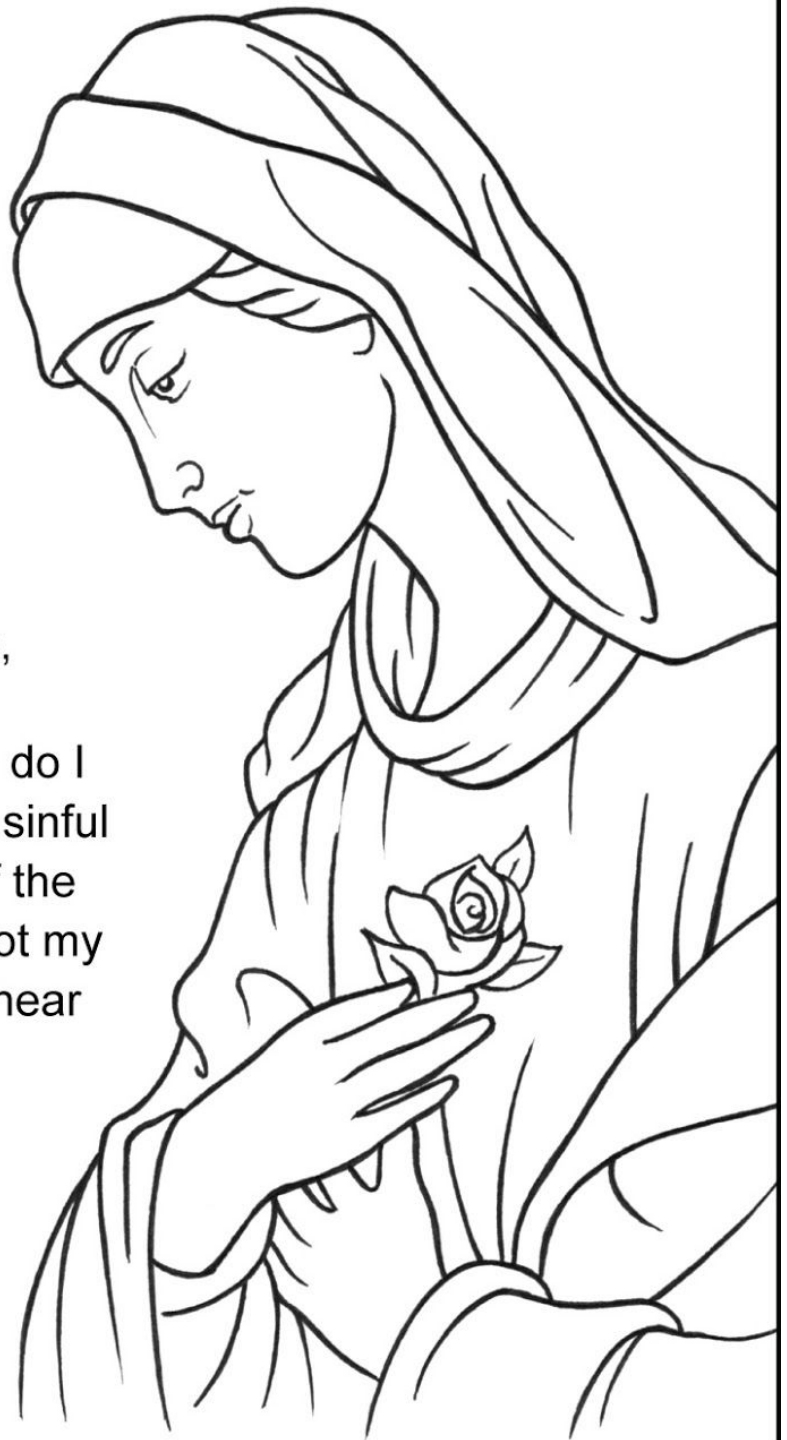
- Practice math skills on the IXL website

and answer me.





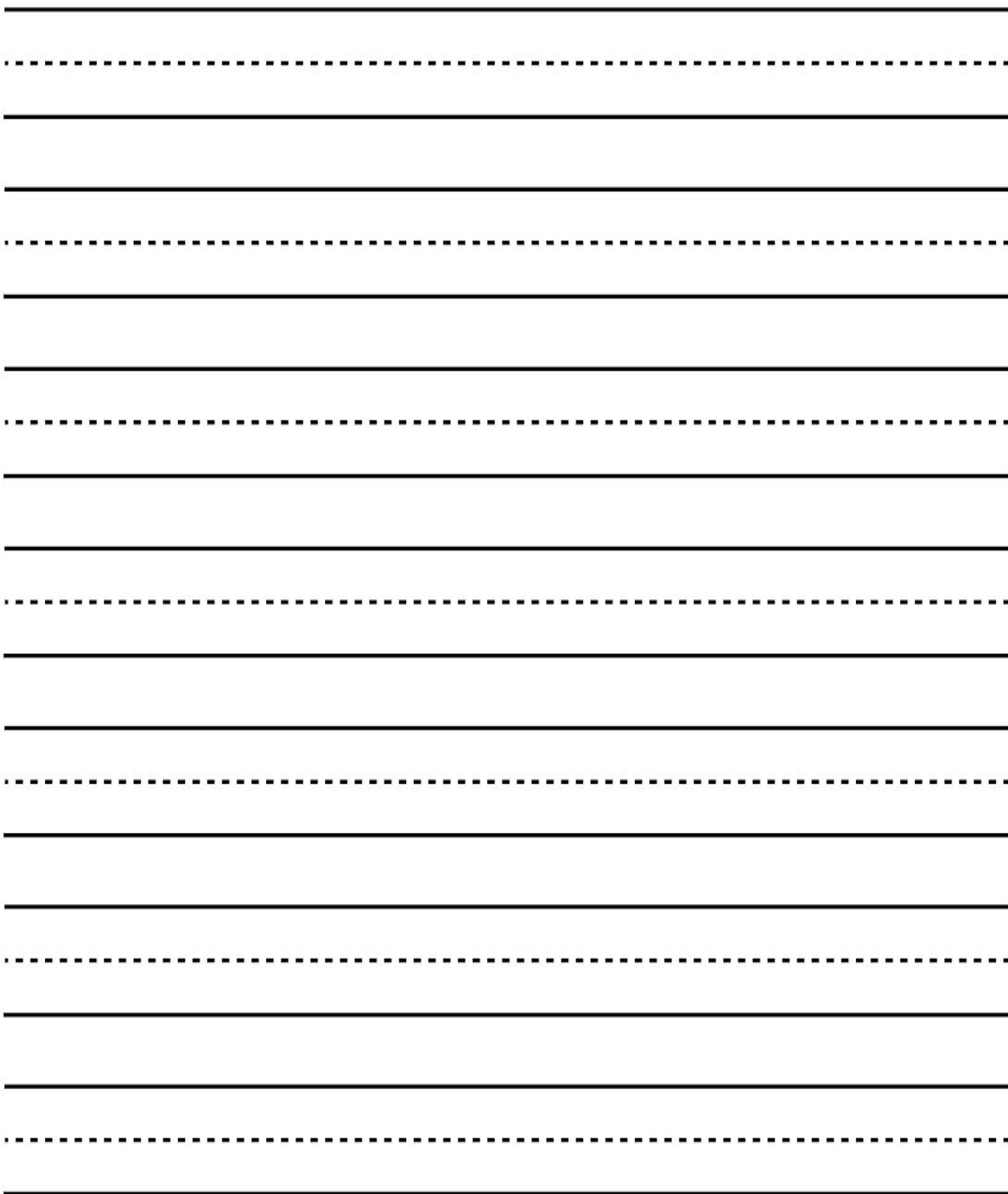
