Fine Motor Tweezer Activity:

Supplies you will need: Water bottle (or some other cleaned out bottle), kitchen tongs or tweezers, cotton balls or small balled up white paper. You do not need to decorate the bottle but if you want to, it is super cute! The idea is to use the tongs or tweezers to pick up the "snowballs" and put them into the bottle.
