A prayer of **PETITION** humbly asks God for something that you need or wish. It is also a petition prayer to ask God to help someone else.

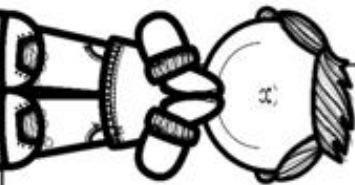
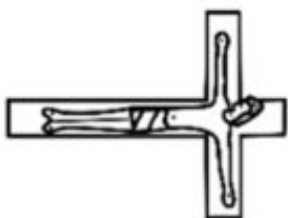


A prayer of **THANKSGIVING** says thank you to God for blessings in one's life.

Penguins like to play with each other. They like to slide on their tummies through the snow and the ice. They also like to dive in the water. Penguins are fun to learn about!

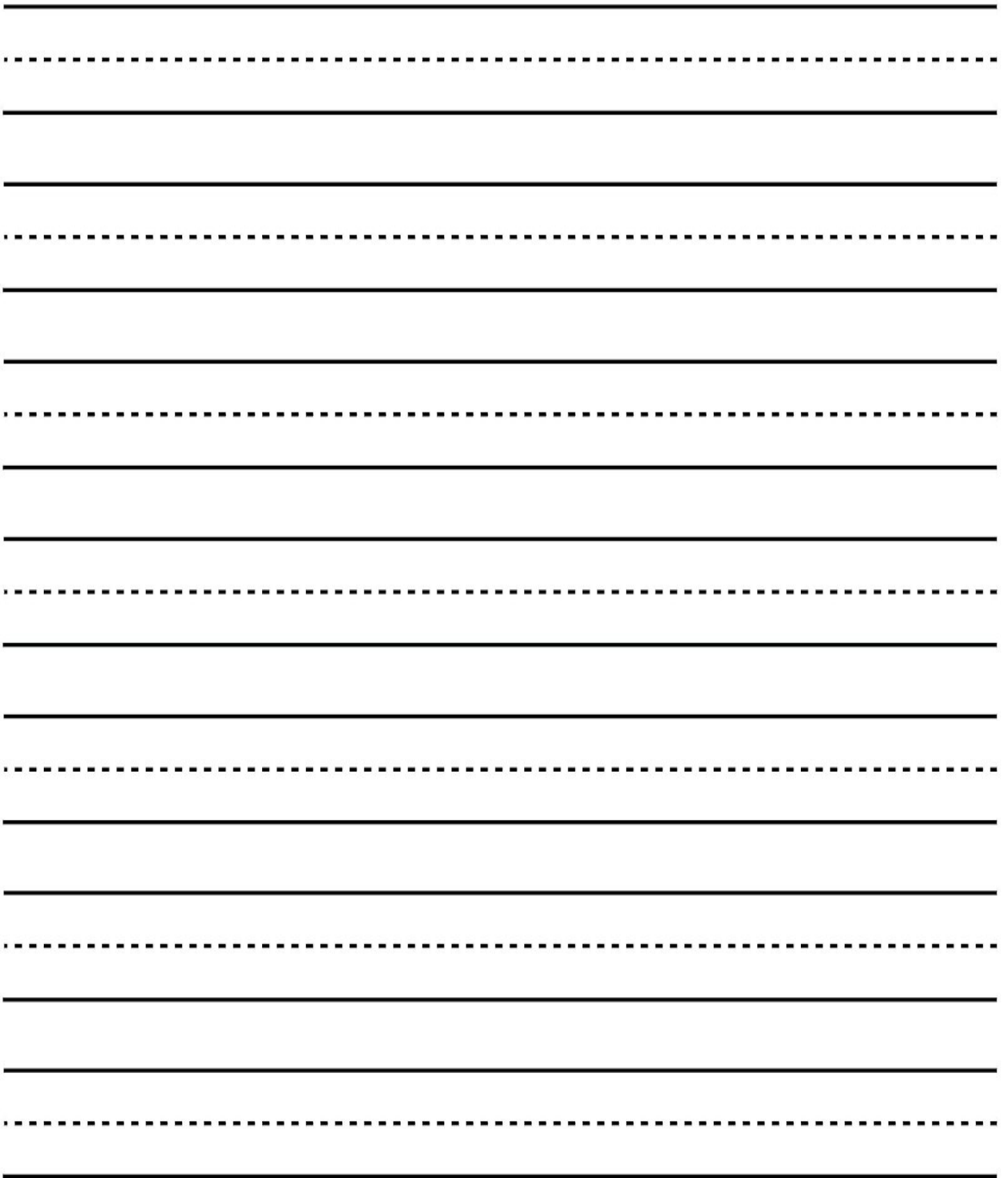
