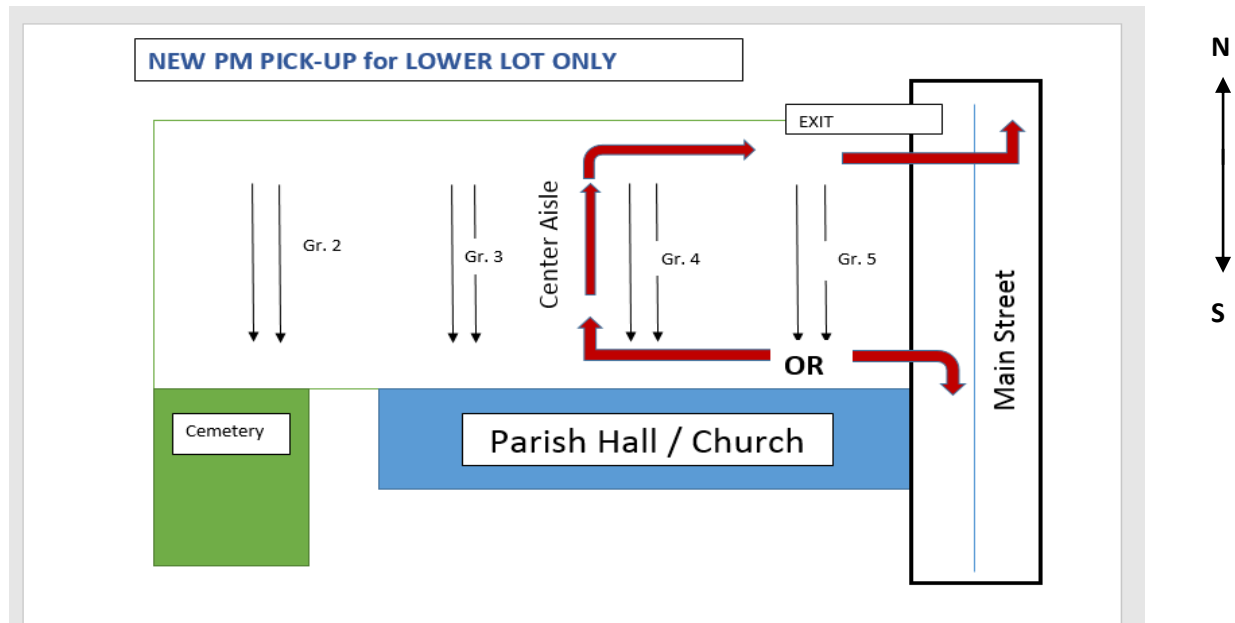
In order to efficiently, effectively, and safely proceed with ***afternoon dismissal***, we are going to change the way you are asked to line up your vehicles. **THIS IS ONLY FOR THE LOWER LOT "A"**.

In the lower lot, we will now be lining cars up **WITHIN the lanes** and **NOT in parking spots**. In other words, cars will line up bumper to bumper. The first car in each line will face the church/parish hall. Each row will have **TWO lanes** of vehicles. **Signs, cones, teachers, and patrol students will be there to direct you into your appropriate location.**

Grades 2,3,4, and 5 will remain in the **SAME** area as before. **FOR SAFETY, no cars will move until students are in the cars**, we will still **dismiss LANE by LANE**, as indicated by the patrol student and teacher. **As each lane is dismissed, each car may either turn to exit going Right (or turning SOUTH onto) Main Street; OR turn to exit LEFT (or use NORTH exit closest to Church) onto Main Street.**

The detail for the rubric is below, followed by the picture rubric for students.



## Reading and Writing Assessments Grading Guide

When grading the summative and formative assessments for reading, use the grading scale listed below. Based on the content level demonstrated, give the student a score between 4.0 and 0.

Score	Content Level	Description
4.0	Student is able to go beyond the grade level target goal, demonstrating an understanding of more complex content.	Wow
3.5	Student is able to meet the grade level target learning goal along with demonstrating the ability to add complex content.	Experienced
3.0	Student is able to meet grade level target learning goal.	Competent
2.5	Student demonstrates a simple understanding of the grade level target goal and has partial success at score 3.0 content.	Developing
2.0	Student is working towards an understanding of the grade level target learning goal, but still may be in need of additional instruction and/or support.	Developing
1.5	Student has partial success at score 2.0 content.	Emerging
1.0	Student demonstrates minimal understanding of grade level target learning goal.	Emerging
0.5	Student has partial success, with help, at score 1.0 content.	Not Yet
0	Even with help, no success.	Not Yet

After scoring the assessment, enter the corresponding percentage below as the grade.
