“Boxes of Hope”

A United Effort of Assumption Schools Day and PSR



(1 box per family is being requested)

GOAL: to help children from around the world (including our local pre-teens and teens) to get a gift-box for Christmas.

If choosing to participate, please have your BOX of HOPE back to school on November 9th.

On Friday, October 26th your child will be bringing home an Operation Christmas Child shoebox (grades Pre-K through 4th) or a white “shoebox” (grades 5-8) for our local St. Vincent DePaul Pre-teen and Teens Christmas boxes. *This will follow an Assembly we have planned for a Project we are calling “Boxes of HOPE” in light of our theme of HOPE for 2018-2019.*



Operation Christmas Child – Grades Pre-K -4 families are asked to fill 1 box with toy-type items. On the box, you will check what the age group of child you wish to help, and whether it is a boy or girl. (Crayons, coloring books, small stuffed animals, ribbons for girls, cars for boys, pencils and sharpeners, etc. – the Dollar Store is a great place to shop)

Do Not Include

Candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

St. Vincent de Paul – Grades 5-8 families are asked to fill 1 box for a Pre—Teen or Teen.

If your child is a boy, please select a boy (likewise for the girls). Whatever your child's age is the age of the person you will buy for. (If your son is 13, then he will fill a box for a boy age 13).

Items such as: Bath Bombs for girls, Lotions, Make-up /Nail Polish, Posters (boys or girls), I-tunes, Starbucks, V-Bucks gift cards, Lava Lamps, necklace, watch, earrings, scarf, mittens, hat, headphones, slime items, hair dryers, straighteners. *Be creative for boys and girls up to age 15.*

We know these items are costly and 1 item is perfect for a box.
